In case of absence for Document Verification, the next eligible candidate on the merit list will be considered.)

All the candidates aspiring to take admission in the College in **First Year of Five-Year Law Course Institutional Level Round Merit List** should take note that:

1. Candidates must be present to report between 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon to take a token number for verification of documents in the College Office personally.
2. After collecting the token number, students will have to arrange and produce original documents as per the list for verification and submission. Admission will be confirmed only on production of all required documents.
3. Students have to fill the Pre-online Registration Form of University of Mumbai on: [mum.digitaluniversity.ac](http://mum.digitaluniversity.ac)
4. Anti-Ragging Affidavit – To be submitted by both the student and parent/guardian. Generate online at: [https://www.antiragging.in/affidavit\\_affiliated\\_form.php](https://www.antiragging.in/affidavit_affiliated_form.php)
5. APPR ID / ABC ID – To be submitted by all students. This can be generated online. <https://abc.gov.in>
6. After verification of documents, candidates shall have to fill the online College Admission Form (link will be provided by the college after verification).



7. Candidates who fulfil all the above requirements will be allowed to pay fees online through UPI / QR Code / Net Banking.
8. Payment receipt will be issued after the completion of all admission formalities.
9. The candidates are required to carry all original certificates/documents with two attested photocopies for admission.
10. In case the candidates are awarded Grades/CGPA instead of marks, the conversion of Grade/CGPA to percentage of marks would be based on the formula/procedure certified by the Board/University/Institution who has awarded the same. It is obligatory on the part of the candidate to bring the conversion certificate from the Board/University/Institution.
11. Candidates are informed to bring the documents as per the information brochure published by State CET Cell.

## Step for Anti Ragging form

### 5. Open the Official Portal

Go to [antiragging.in](http://antiragging.in)

On the homepage, you will see options like “Fill Undertaking”, “Download Undertaking”, etc.

### 6. Select “Fill Undertaking”

Click this option to open the online form. You’ll need to fill details such as:

Student’s name, address, date of birth

College name, course, year of study

Parent/guardian’s details

### 7. Fill the Form and Submit

Enter all the required information carefully and click Submit.

Once submitted, the system will generate a PDF version of your affidavit (undertaking).

### 8. Download the PDF Affidavit

The affidavit will appear on your screen and will also be sent to your registered email.

Download it and take a printout.



## APAAR ID Generation Process

### 7. Visit the Official Portal

Open: <https://abc.gov.in>

Click “Student” → “Create ABC ID”.

### 8. Login via DigiLocker

You will be redirected to the DigiLocker login page.

Enter the mobile number linked with your Aadhaar.

Login using the OTP received.

### 9. Aadhaar Authentication

Enter your Aadhaar number and verify with OTP.

Your basic details will be fetched automatically from UIDAI.

### 10. Fill in Additional Details

Add your email ID and mobile number (if not already filled).

Enter your institution/college details.

### 11. Submit the Form

Review all details carefully.

Click Submit to generate your APAAR ID / ABC ID instantly.

### 12. Save Your APAAR ID

Download the PDF card or note down the APAAR ID (a unique alphanumeric code).

Use this ID for all academic records and admissions.

#### **Note:**

Aadhaar must be linked with your mobile number.

Once generated, the APAAR ID is valid for a lifetime.
